Dear Year 6 parents/carers,

Year Six Graduation/End of Year News!

I love this time of the year as we all look forward to the 'hustle and bustle' of our Y6 Graduation Ceremony and Ball. I think it was 2008 that we had our first Graduation, uncertain about how it would work, but now planning our 11<sup>th</sup> we would feel lost without this new tradition. What happens on the actual day (Thursday 19th July) is at 2pm to approx. 3pm we have a formal ceremony in the school hall (all welcome!) and at 6 to 8pm on that evening a Graduation Ball for the children, also in the hall (once it has been transformed from 3.30pm).
