Remember to use <u>different colours</u> for each feature to make it clear what you're showing us! Use our HL Country Research sheet to write down short bits of information about a country of your choice.				Over this term, our Maths focus is on Multiplication and Division. To help understand that we will be looking at Arrays. Arrays show objects in rows and columns to help us see multiplication. They make counting easier and show that, for example, 3 × 4 is the same as 4 × 3. Look at the HL Using Arrays and answer the questions to help you understand this clearer.
