

Stone Age Animals – Comprehension Answers (Parent Copy)

1. Woolly mammoths looked like large elephants with long, shaggy hair. They were useful to Stone Age people because they provided meat for food, skins for clothing and shelters, and tusks and bones for making tools.

2. The woolly rhinoceros was adapted to the cold environment because it was covered in thick fur. It also had strong horns to defend itself from predators like wolves and cave lions.

3. The giant deer's huge antlers made the males look impressive and may have helped them in fights or to attract mates. However, the antlers also made it difficult for them to move through thick forests.

4. These animals show that Stone Age life was dangerous and required bravery and skill. Hunting these large animals provided food, clothing, and tools, but was risky and challenging.
