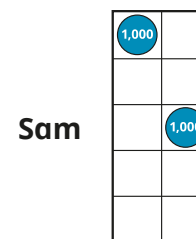
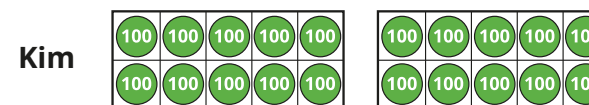
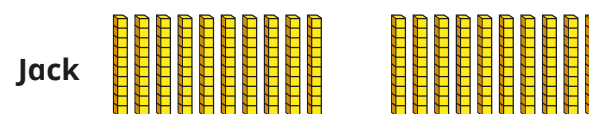
Explain the mistake that Tiny has made.
