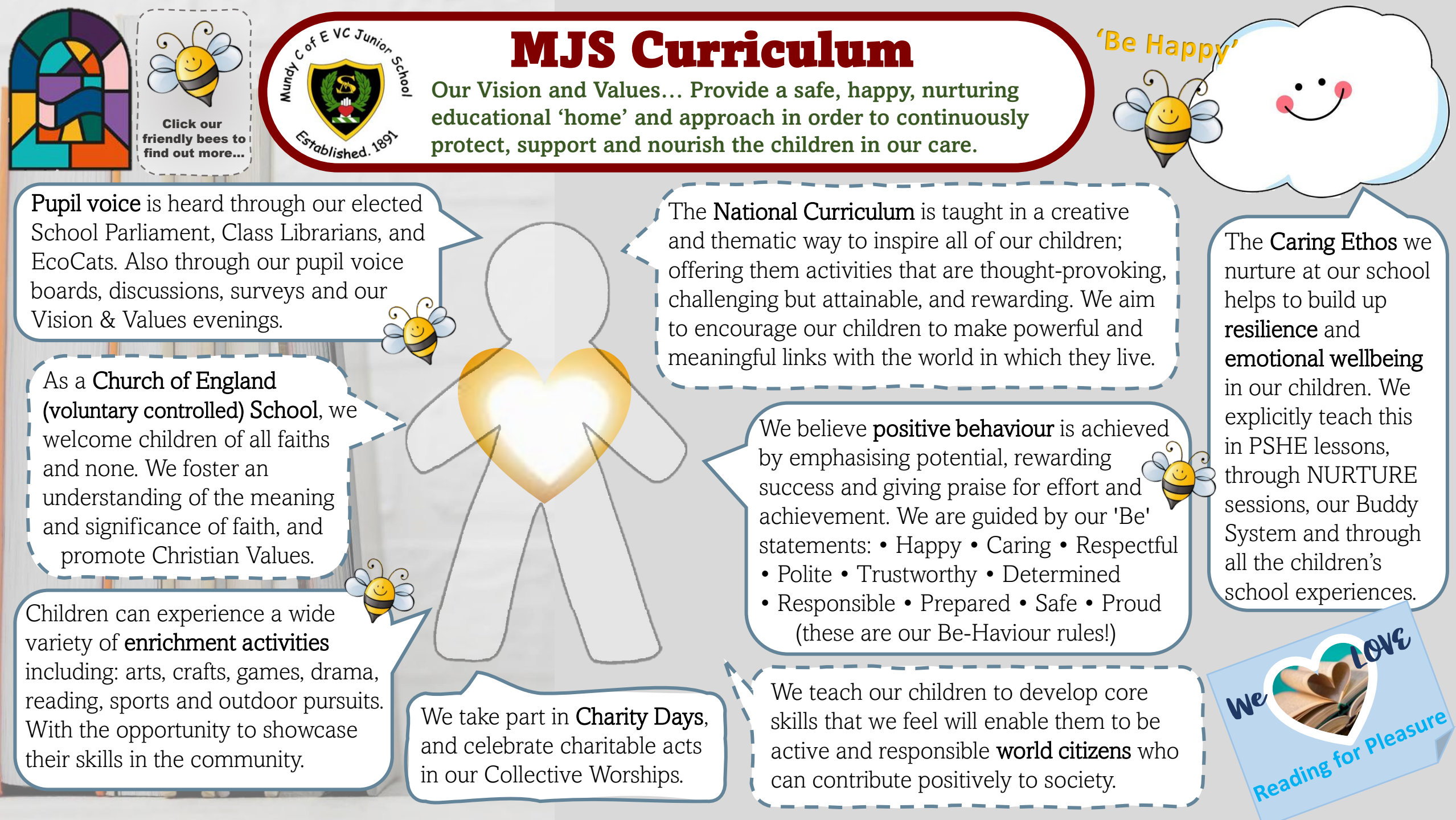




MJS Curriculum
