<u>Our aims are:</u> Our History curriculum aims to give all children opportunities to develop the following concepts: • Investigate and interpret the past; • Build an overview of world history; • Understand chronology and see historical development from a local and national level; • Communicate with the correct historical vocabulary, with it being provided in lessons for students to use and consistently be provided on Working Walls. Within each historical period that we study, our lessons will explore the following knowledge categories: • Location • Settlements • Food and farming • Conflict • Travel and exploration • Beliefs As well as looking at key historical terms.	<u>We will implement this by:</u> Using our Creative Curriculum which teaches historical subjects from the National Curriculum over 2 year cycle. The Creative Curriculum includes the study of historical events in other subjects and include those in the history lessons to provide additional background on a theme/event/period. Working Walls will contain relevant chronological context of a historical event/period as well as provide a consistent resource for children to refer back to for key historical terms/definitions.	We aim for our pupils to be to able to ask perceptive questions and think critically. As well as having a good understanding of historical concepts and chronology. This will be assessed by teachers using a grid of historian-based skills taken from the National Curriculum.
